5-29-07 – “Most irrigated wheat is still not ready. One grower is cutting HWW in South Kern County, 63+ test weight, 14+ pro. Same situation with a grower in Corcoran. A few "dryland" loads were received over the weekend, 63 lb test weight, 12 pro. Hopefully, harvest will get going in the next few days.” Mike Holdsworth, Western Milling, Goshen, CA

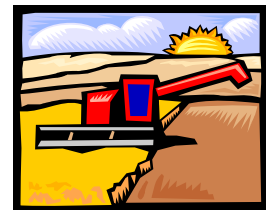
5-29-07 - “ Harvest in San Joaquin County and the nearby area should begin in the next couple of weeks.” Tim Grunsky, Phil O’Connell Grain, Stockton, CA

5-31-07 – “We will start cutting a few fields on Monday.” Larry Hunn, Grower, Clarksburg, CA

5-31-07 – “Growers have been harvesting barley in our area for the past few weeks. Today we will start harvesting our own wheat fields. The wheat in this area looks fantastic.” Tom Millar, Grower, Glenn, CA

5-31-07 – “We are probably 30 days away from harvest. Growers that did not irrigate their wheat do not have a crop to harvest.” Charles Darway, Grower, San Luis Obispo, CA

5-31-07 – “The Imperial Valley harvest is in full swing. It appears 95% or better of the samples are grading US#1. General observation on dockage is that it appears pretty low this year.” Albert Santana, Farwell Grain Inspection, Imperial Valley, CA
